Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The HILLTOP WSC water system PWS ID 1550032 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

We are addressing a violation with TCEQ on submitting our Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report later than the 10 days required to do so at the end of each quarter.

We apologize to all our customers for the inconvenience. My wife, Sharon and I were very ill at the end of March and fell behind on submitting the City of Abbott quarterly report.

During this quarter we took 92 chlorine residuals from the system and 270 residuals from the well site from the Hilltop WSC. We also had 12 microbial samples that were all good and free from coliform bacteria and E coli. during this time period, January 1st – March 31st. This report was sent to TCEQ in April of 2021 but was after the 10th of April, which is required.

We regret and again apologize that we were past due on submitting the testing results to TCEQ and will stay on top of the situation to make sure this does not happen again.
